A wider range of people will be involved in heritage


- There will be more people engaging with heritage and this audience will be more diverse than before your project.

An example of leadership – the Heritage Soapbox event April 2018. We supported our young ambassadors to run an inclusive practice event demanding participation in heritage for young people -25.


